## **MMAC Suit Seeks to Enjoin City Sick Leave Ordinance**

The Metropolitan Milwaukee Association of Commerce (MMAC) filed suit against the City of Milwaukee today seeking to enjoin the implementation of Milwaukee's Paid Sick Leave Ordinance (the Ordinance) and its invalidation. The suit seeks both temporary and permanent stays. MMAC challenges the validity of the Ordinance on the following bases:

- It exceeds the City's constitutional and statutory authority;
