Wisconsin Governor Signs Law Preempting Milwaukee Paid Sick Leave Ordinance

Last week, Wisconsin Governor Scott Walker signed into law a bill that preempts the Milwaukee Paid Sick Leave Ordinance. The bill, as outlined in our [Special Alert on April 13, 2011](#), prohibits any local community within the state - city, village, town or county - from passing its own paid or unpaid leave mandate.
